

Elementary Student Dress Code

All Students:

- All clothing must portray a clean, modest, neat, not tight-fitting look that supports a learning environment.
- Hats are only allowed to be worn outside (i.e. not in classes, chapels, etc).
- While girls may have pierced ears, no other body piercings are allowed for boys or girls.
- Girls in the elementary may not wear makeup.
- Tattoos and intentional “body-scarring” or other such styles are prohibited. Any infraction will result in expulsion unless removed.

Elementary Girls:

Skirts/dresses:

- Must be modest in length.
- For the sake of modesty while on the playground, shorts, spanx, leggings, or tights must be worn underneath skirts and dresses.
- If hemline is higher than the knee, leggings or tights must be worn underneath.

Pants:

- Must be neat, clean, and in good condition (no holes or patches). Many fabrics, colors, and patterns are acceptable, as long as undergarments do not show through. Jeans are permitted. Pants may be as short as mid-way between the ankle and knee.
- Jeggings, sweatpants, pajama pants, athletic warm-ups, or nylon breakaway pants are not permitted.
- Leggings are permitted when worn with an appropriate skirt or dress, but are not allowed to be worn as pants alone.

Shorts:

- Long shorts (administration-approved style only)
 - Only khaki, navy, black, or gray shorts are acceptable. Denim shorts are not allowed.
 - Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
 - The shorts are not to be tight-fitting or of tight-fitting fabric.
 - Running or athletic shorts are not allowed unless approved for a special event by the principal.

Shirts:

- Shoulder straps must be at least 2 inches in width.
- Tops must be modest and not revealing.
- Girls may wear nice shirts with appropriate graphics or wording (i.e. rainbows, puppies, unicorns).
- No underclothes should be visible at any time.
- When jackets or sweatshirts are worn, shirts underneath must conform to dress codes guidelines.

Shoes:

- Must be worn at all times.
- Sandals with back straps are permitted.

Hairstyles:

- Must be natural and neat (unusual styles or coloring of the hair is not acceptable).

Elementary Boys:

Pants:

- Must be neat, clean, and in good condition (no holes or patches). Jeans are permitted.
- Sweatpants, pajama pants, athletic warm-ups, or nylon breakaway pants are not permitted.

Shorts:

- Long shorts (administration-approved style only)
 - Only khaki, navy, black, or gray shorts are acceptable. Denim shorts are not allowed.
 - Shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
 - The shorts are not to be tight-fitting or of tight-fitting fabric.
 - Running or athletic shorts are not allowed unless approved for a special event by the principal.

Shirts:

- Full-front buttoned shirts must remain appropriately buttoned.
- All short and long sleeve shirts and tops shall not have any writing, pictures, or graphics unless authorized and purchased through the school. One small-size logo or embroidery on the short or long sleeve shirts will be allowed.
- Plain white t-shirts (undershirts) are not allowed.
- No sports jerseys may be worn.
- When jackets or sweatshirts are worn, shirts underneath must conform to dress codes guidelines.
- Sweaters may be worn without a collar.

Shoes:

- Must be worn at all times.
- Sandals with back straps are permitted.

Hairstyles:

- Must be natural, trimmed, and neat.
- Hair is not to extend over the ears, and must be styled to remain above the eyebrows, and not touching the standard collar.
- No part of the scalp may be shaved.
- No extreme styles of hair will be permitted.
- No bleaching or coloring of hair is allowed. Hair may not have a two-tone appearance or have a "spiked" appearance.
