Important Camp Information

WHO: 7th - 12th Grades

WHEN: Wednesday, 8/29 - Friday, 8/31

WHY:

- * To build unity and purpose among our students

HOW TO REGISTER:

- * Complete the Camp Registration form
- * Open your family's TADS account to make a payment. **\$160 is to be paid in full by Friday, August 24. To reserve your child's spot at camp, a minimum deposit of \$60 is due by Friday, August 17.**
- * Junior High families can see a one-time family discount reflected on the August invoice in your TADS account upon registration.
- * A late fee of \$10 will be charged for any late registrations received after **Friday, August 24.**

BRING:

- * Sleeping bag & pillow (nice cabins to house us)
- * Sweatshirt or light-weight jacket
- * Cooler clothes (dress code length shorts, etc.)
- * Bible
- * Two pairs of shoes
- * Toiletries & towels (there are showers in each cabin)
- * Sunscreen
- * Modest Swimsuit (one piece suits for girls)
- * **One** medium suitcase or duffel bag per student
- * Spending money for the camp snack store (optional)
- * Your own flashlight (it is quite dark in the evenings!)



OTHER INFO:

1. It is our desire that all of the Junior High and High School students go with us to camp. There are no classes for those who do not go to camp. Those students who do not attend camp will be considered absent from school.
2. If your student needs to take **any medication(s), even the over-the-counter variety, please see the enclosed medication form. ALL MEDICATION MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE HIGH SCHOOL OFFICE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS PRIOR TO THE DEPARTURE FOR CAMP AND WILL BE DISPENSED BY SCHOOL OFFICIALS ONLY.**
