Medicine Information and Parental Release



1. **ALL medication, including non-prescription drugs and over-the-counter medications,** requires a signed release from the parents of the student to allow our school personnel to administer the medicine as needed at camp.
2. **ALL medication sent to camp must be in the original container(s).** They must be turned in to the High School Office with this signed release **BEFORE** the students go to camp. Medications will not be accepted or administered if they are submitted in household containers, envelopes, or baggies.
3. Specific instructions for the administration of each medication should be given so that we may be able to administer these medications accurately.
4. The medications will be kept in strict confidence with only school officials administering them. The only medication that may be administer without this release form is Tylenol or Ibuprofen **if** you have already marked the release on our Emergency Cards allowing us to do this.
