

Academic Performance Index Scores (API)
For 7th – 10th Grades

The API is a way that the state uses to compare public schools' performances. The Stanford Achievement Test plus a weighted formula is used to receive the score that is comparable to their score. The scale goes from 200 – 1000 with 800 being the target goal defining a high level of performance.
